

Housegroups

(Run term time only)

The house groups have elements of all Leeds Vineyard Core Priorities. Young people engage in in a range of worship activities and are encouraged to encounter lesus for themselves. They are also supported in developing a close relationship with lesus, their families and their peers. Young people are given many opportunities to read the Bible, engage with it and respond to it. This is supported through opportunities to pray for one another. their friends, communities and world issues. Each house group is intentional about leading the young people as disciples and giving them the tools they need to live out their faith in their own situations. The young people are encouraged to share their faith and to find ways they can serve the church and support compassion ministries or charities that they resonate with.

Mentoring

We recognise that young people thrive best when they have someone who can act as a sounding board and a good role model in following Jesus. Therefore, some of our young people have opted to have a specific mentor, with whom they can discuss their lives, challenges, issues, hopes, aspirations and dreams, on a one to one basis. This is arranged through Liz & Ian who will dialogue with the young person and their parents so that the best mentor for that young person can be arranged.

For all young people, we are providing group mentoring through two groups: Boundless (11-18vr bovs) and **Stronger** (11-18vr girls). The aim of these groups is to work on team building and discipleship in the context of achieving something together. The groups are made up of youth and a number of adults who are looking to actively build young people's self esteem, confidence, faith in lesus and relationship with one another. These activities can include adventure activities, community projects, challenges and outings. On occasions Boundless and Stronger will collaborate on a project.
